Customers sign up for CCI ScreenFlow via Service Bureau's Alliance Gateway Web Services Host Adaptor

As Euroclear moves into the implementation phase for ESES and the Single Platform, Euroclear has chosen to offer the automated and screen-based interfaces of its Common Communication Interface (CCI) under trademark names (pending registration).

The Euroclear ScreenFlow application is an interactive user interface that is based on synchronous request and response interactions, and combines a file upload and download mechanism. For configuration purposes this mandatory channel offers interactive access to the Euroclear CCI infrastructure, and enables Euroclear customers to manage the relationship with Euroclear (operators' management).

Customers use ScreenFlow for the following purposes:

- To send instructions
- To receive reports
- To perform administrative tasks (for example, user configuration for the straight through processing message-by-message channel)

All business functions are accessible through this screen channel.

CCI Screenflow Connectivity with Decillion Group Service Platform

EuroClear customers who are interested in connecting to Euroclear CCI Screenflow can choose to connect by either having their own direct connection or by an indirect connection. Decillion Group offers customers an indirect connection solution via our Service Platform.

With the Decillion Group's offering, EuroClear customers will only require a PC (with browser) connected to Decillion Group's Alliance Gateway Servers (SAG) via a broadband internet available from their local Internet Service Provider (ISP). The EuroClear CCI Screenflow application is downloaded and installed on the PC. Network security is ensured by the use of VPN technology provided by Decillion Group.

With Decillion Group's indirect connection solution, CCI Screenflow at the customer site will be able to securely access the EuroClear Application with minimal implementation costs and infrastructure setup.
